
III. **Plate – Shop Section**

- Exposed to fabrication work of various items such as buoys and slipway carriages. This covers plate preparation like marking the material then ox-acetylene gas cutting the material to size. The section that forms the cylindrical part of the buoy is then rolled and finally the ends of which are electro-arc welded.
- The basic welding techniques of surface preparation and then welding using Electro-Arch welding equipment or ox-acetylene equipment was demonstrated during the fabrication of the slipway carriages.

IV. **Marine Afloat Workshop**

- Worked under supervision of the Marine Afloat staff, whose functions basically are to operate the already serviced marine craft. This involves preparing the main propulsion engines for starting (like running the priming pump to lubricate the system before applying the starting air to crank the engine to speed and then fire the engine by applying fuel) then there after monitoring the engine parameters while the engine is running on load.

Mr. Idris is very hardworking, co-operative, dedicated, industrious, team player and his work performance and knowledge of Marine systems is satisfactory.



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
