- Ensure the use of proper Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) at all times, and enforce safety standards among crew in the garbage areas.
- Collaborate effectively with multinational crew members and maintain clear communication in English, Kiswahili, and Spanish.
- Support emergency response operations including fire drills and safety inspections, adhering to STCW and company regulations.
