- Played assistant role in the dry-docking operation of the vessels so as to access the propulsion shafts, ship keel, propeller blades for inspection, maintenance, and cleaning.
- Practiced good housekeeping in the engine room by ensuring a clean and empty engine room bilge, painting of
 rusting engine room bulkheads, engine parts, pipes, tanks, cleaning of spilled fuel oil, and proper tools storage
 etc.
